S2W provides young Indigenous Australians with work experience, mentoring and leadership opportunities that lead to a successful outcome.

PROGRAM STEPS

HOW DOES IT WORK

Selected year 11 and 12 students from participating schools conduct a one-on-one profiling session with their Project Officer to build Career Development Plans focussed on career aspirations and personal goals.

Students work with their Project Officers to pursue these plans by participating in educational, cultural and leadership workshops. They also visit club sponsors, partner organisations, universities and other government and corporate supporters of S2W to undertake work experience and job-readiness training.



Graduating students are equipped to make informed choices about their future careers, are armed with exceptional leadership capabilities and have a solid foundation in job ready skills and qualifications.



To help guide students through a smooth transition to life after school, the S2W Program continues mentorship for up to 12 months post schooling, with close monitoring of their progress on a structured 'post-school' plan.
